

## A) Funding Opportunities

### NCN

- [OPUS 20 + LAP](#) – proposals covering basic research projects in any of [25 NCN panels](#);

Duration of project – 12 to 48 months, PI - researchers with at least one publication (whether or not holding a PhD degree)

**NEW!** Research projects within the cooperation with research teams from the Czech Republic, Austria, Slovenia, Germany or Switzerland – OPUS LAP proposals

**DEADLINE: 15.12.2020**

- [SONATA 16](#) – for funding of basic research projects in any of [25 NCN panels](#);

Duration of project – 12 to 36 months, PI - a person who has been conferred a PhD degree within 2 to 7 years before the proposal submission year

**DEADLINE: 15.12.2020**

- [PRELUDIUM BIS 2](#) – for institutions operating doctoral schools to support PhD students,

Duration of project – 36 to 48 months, PI - a research supervisor of the PhD student carrying out a research project, Funding – funds for research up to 180,000 PLN, doctoral scholarships and indirect costs up to 20%

**DEADLINE: 15.12.2020**

**WARNING!** A person may act as the PI under one edition of calls only **once** – applies to OPUS 20, SONATA 16 and PRELUDIUM BIS 2.

- [CEUS-UNISONO](#) – call for proposals for bilateral or trilateral research projects in all academic disciplines to be carried out by research teams from Austria, the Czech Republic, Slovenia and Poland, projects **with the added value of international cooperation**

Duration of project – 24 to 36 months or up to 48 months for cooperation with Austria, PI – person with at least PhD degree, NCN cannot act as the lead agency

**DEADLINE: 31.12.2020**

**PANDEMIC VERSION** – research projects on humanitarian crises like epidemics and pandemics carried out jointly by research teams from Poland and Austria, with the participation of research teams from Germany or Switzerland or Luxembourg – here **deadline 15.12.2020**

## **NAWA**

- [NAWA Urgency Grants](#) – for research activities that may not be implemented by applying for other existing funding mechanisms due to the need for a rapid response, international cooperation of research teams or international mobility of scientists

Duration of project – 3 to 12 months, Funding – up to 500,000 PLN, grant receiving possible only when proving the potential loss of a unique opportunity to solve an important problem

**DEADLINE: 31.12.2020 – call conducted on a continuous basis (until the end of budget)**

## **NCBiR**

- [Fast track – Coronaviruses](#) – for preventing the spread of viruses, with particular emphasis on a pandemic SARS-CoV-2 coronavirus

**Objective:** industrial research and/or experimental research work (possibly supplemented with pre-implementation), which result in the development of an innovative solution;

**For whom:** available for research institutes only in consortium with enterprises where the leader is always the enterprise

**Realization of project:** to 30.06.2023

**DEADLINE: 31.12.2020**

## B) Internships/Fellowships

- [Fulbright – BioLAB Program 2021-22](#) – one-year, paid internship for students of biological sciences (biology, biochemistry, biotechnology, chemistry, physics, pharmacy, etc.) in four American scientific institutions

**For whom:** PhD or master's degree students

**DEADLINE: 01.02.2021**

- [NAWA exchange program for students and scientists as part of bilateral cooperation](#) – applies to exchanges that will take place in the academic year 2021/22

Duration of exchange – 5 days to 12 months, Purposes – from short research visits to longer research internships, an invitation or confirmation of the existing cooperation with hosting party is necessary for obtaining a scholarship

**DEADLINE: 18.12.2020**

**For whom:** a PhD student or person with a PhD degree born in 1990 or later

**DEADLINE: 18.12.2020 (but list of publications or research achievements dating up to 02.11.2020)**
